



Education for Ministry (EfM) is a unique four-year distance learning certificate program in theological education based upon small-group study and practice. EfM is a part of the School of Theology of The University of the South in Sewanee, Tennessee.

Started in 1975, this international program has assisted more than 120,000 participants in discovering and nurturing their call to Christian service. EfM helps the faithful encounter the breadth and depth of the Christian tradition and bring it into conversation with their experiences of the world as they study, worship, and engage in theological reflection together.

The program invites participants into small, mentored groups that provide the framework for understanding life and shaping actions as Christian faith is deepened. EfM seminar groups meet in local settings and online, and provide a four-year curriculum that develops a theologically informed, reflective, and articulate laity.

We welcome all to consider participating in EfM. Members of our EfM group bring an array of faith backgrounds and beliefs. Whether you have always wanted to read the Bible or if you have studied scripture throughout your life, EfM provides an opportunity to deepen your faith and understanding of Christianity. Our group includes members from Oregon and New Mexico. We meet virtually on Monday evenings from 6:30–8 pm from September to May each year. Weekly readings are discussed along with a Theological Reflection. What awaits is community, conversation, listening, and sharing.
