### **Guest Priest**

**Carolyn Metzler**—The Rev. Metzler grew up in Indonesia where her parents were Protestant missionaries. She became an Episcopalian while studying at Hope College in Holland, Michigan. For five years she was a professed member of the Society of St. Margaret, an Episcopal order of monastic women in Duxbury, Mass. She is a 1990 graduate of Andover-Newton Theological School in Newton, Mass. with a master’s degree in cross-cultural theology.

Metzler was ordained as a priest in 2004 by The Rt. Rev.

Chilton R. Knudsen. She served St. Thomas Episcopal Church in Winn, Maine from 2004 to 2009 when she and her husband, Dr. Eric W. Metzler, a gerontologist, moved to Albuquerque to continue his medical practice. In Albuquerque, she has served at several churches while maintaining a practice in hospice chaplaincy and spiritual direction.
